Mitali ---- the Women Cell of Raja Peary Mohan College was established in 2012. The primary mission of Mitali is to provide a gender-neutral environment so as to ensure basic right to work and study with dignity and to promote gender sensitization among staff and students of the institution. Women Cell aims at accomplishing gender equality, preventing gender discrimination and promoting a social, physical and psychological environment that is congenial for all. Women Cell, thus, plays an active role in gender sensitization and gender related issues. Activities of women cell are varied and diverse ranging from promotion of gender equality and gender sensitization to promotion of social awareness among women regarding health, hygiene and other issues. Women Cell organizes Health Camp in association with eminent organizations like Frank Ross, for routine health check-up of the girl students and women staff of the college. Varied Workshops ranging from stress management to self-defence techniques and seminars/webinars on gender issues like sexual harassment are organized by Women Cell. Cultural programmes are also organized by the Cell to celebrate Women's Day, Mother's Day etc. With active participation of students, Women Cell undertakes various programmes related to community service, self-defence of girls and soft skill development Women Cell also publishes an annual bi-lingual magazine Ardhek Prithibi on gender related issues.
